VOLUNTEER

- **Donation Center:** sorting and packing donations. Hours are flexible - Tuesdays / Thursdays 8:00 am - 12:00 pm & Saturdays 8:00 - 12:00 pm
- **Pick up donations:** 4 hours per week, usually on Tuesdays, but pick ups are flexible.
- **Help load trucks:** load furniture & other items, usually once a week.
- **Driver deliver donations:** to our partners in Appalachia : No CDL required; most trips are day trips.

OUR MISSION


- to support our ministry partners
