The Appalachian Mountain Ministry has been working like busy little bees all spring. God has richly blessed this ministry with goods from many places and we have been packing up to three days in one week to get all of the items packed and ready for shipment.

We began using a semi to move the material for the most part up to the sites where they can take a semi. This has allowed us not to burden men near as often to help us load our box truck to go to the sites. However, we have an urgent request that we need help with. We have people who donate goods like furniture and they have no way to get it to us. We badly need a few men who have a pick-up truck who would be willing to help us one day a week to pick up items and bring them to the center. We would provide you names, phone numbers, and directions if we could just get some assistance in this matter. If you would be willing to work one day a week please give us a call at 478-396-9065 or 478-396-9316. We need three or four teams to help us. Your help will be greatly appreciated.

We have just received the Back Pack information for 2018. We will be having a meeting for all POCs at the Association and get that meeting out to WMU organizations in the next two weeks. It will soon be time for all of the school sales and we need to take advantage of that.

We have a need for the following items: undergarments for boys and girls, ages 6-12; socks for the same age groups; and hygiene items for the whole family. These items are badly needed at all sites and if you would like to provide any of these items please bring them to the center on any Tuesday between 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM.

We have been working with the Veterans Affairs office and have provided furniture items to 8 veterans who were homeless and were able to get a place to live and we have provided furniture items to them. The veterans Affairs Office vets the requirements and makes contact with us and if we have material we help them.
