GOD IS GOOD! Thanks to all the churches that promoted our “Coats for Appalachia” project and all the individuals who donated coats we were able to take 13 gaylord boxes to the people in Appalachia. (Gaylords are the huge boxes you see at the grocery store with cantaloupes or watermelons in them). Because of all the support and generosity, the people who receive the coats will be warmer and know that God’s people care about them. We also took 4 gaylord boxes of quality linens to the mountain sites. This was made possible by the generosity of “The Warehouse”.

We will be meeting soon to finalize the planning for backpacks this year. Our goal is to provide 1800 backpacks and have them delivered to the distribution sites in the mountains by October 31. To do this, we must have the backpacks delivered to the RBA Center by September 30. Please start now so you can have a better chance of getting better pricing.

We appreciate all the donations to the Mountain Ministry and ask that you promote the ministry at your church and to your friends. However, there are some items we cannot accept due to the manpower and space required to transport them. These items include pianos, organs, large heavy TVs (although we can accept flat screen TVs), heavy weightlifting equipment, and treadmills.
